Microsoft Edge: The Built-In Option

Windows 11 comes with Microsoft Edge pre-installed, and it's actually quite good these days. Built on the same Chromium engine as Google Chrome, Edge is fast, secure, and deeply integrated with Windows. It also uses less RAM than Chrome, making it a smart pick if your PC is older or has limited memory. Bonus: it has a built-in coupon finder and PDF editor.

Google Chrome: The Popular Choice

Chrome remains the world's most-used browser for good reason - it's fast, reliable, and works seamlessly with Google services like Gmail, Drive, and YouTube. The massive library of extensions lets you customize it endlessly. The downside? It's a memory hog. If you have multiple tabs open, Chrome can slow your whole system down.

Mozilla Firefox: The Privacy Champion

Firefox is the go-to browser for anyone who prioritizes privacy. It's open-source, blocks trackers aggressively, and doesn't harvest your data the way Google does. It's highly customizable and runs well on older hardware.

Brave: The Privacy Newcomer

Brave blocks ads and trackers by default, making pages load faster while protecting your data. It's built on Chromium, so most Chrome extensions work with it.

Which Should You Choose?

- Best overall: Microsoft Edge
- Best for Google users: Chrome
- Best for privacy: Firefox or Brave
- Best for older PCs: Edge or Firefox

Most browsers are free, so don't be afraid to try a couple and see which feels right for you. Your browsing habits are unique - your browser should match them.

Jewelry Reflections



Lustrous Pearls

Pearls have been charming people for thousands of years. Across cultures they've signaled wealth, status, and good taste, and one of the earliest written accounts of pearls comes from a Chinese writer around 2206 BC. In other words: our pearl obsession is delightfully ancient.

Here's the magic: when a tiny irritant slips into a mollusk's shell, the oyster or mussel protects itself by coating it with nacre (that silky, shimmery material). Over time - often years - those layers build a pearl, and the glow comes from light bouncing through the nacre like a built-in spotlight. If nacre forms on the inside of

the shell instead, that's mother of pearl.

Because natural pearls are rare (and nature doesn't do rush orders), most pearls today are cultured. Pearl farmers place a small nucleus - often a rounded piece of shell, commonly sourced from freshwater mussels - into a mollusk to kickstart nacre layering. Truly natural pearls are much harder to find, which is why they usually come with "brace yourself" price tags.

Pearls also come in two main categories: saltwater and freshwater. Saltwater pearls (Akoya, Tahitian, South Sea) grow in coastal waters near places like Japan, China, Australia, and Polynesia. Freshwater pearls grow in rivers and lakes in China, Japan, the U.S., and parts of Europe. Saltwater pearls often cost more, while freshwater pearls deliver lots of variety at a friendlier price.

Pearls are natural and slightly porous, so they can absorb perfume, hairspray, and lotion (not the glowup you want). Quick care tip: put pearls on last, take them off first, and wipe them gently with a soft damp cloth after wearing to keep that luster bright.

Pearls never really go out of style, so let yours have a little spotlight time. And browse SlinkyLynnxChic.com for a plethora of pearls to add to your jewelry box.

Six Ways to Avoid Probate

Here are six tips to help your loved ones avoid the cost and hassle of probate court when the time comes. These suggestions follow the laws of the State of Arizona. Other states may/may not follow all of these suggestions.

What Is Probate? Probate is a legal process by which a deceased person's assets are distributed, final wishes are carried out, and debts are settled. It is a court-supervised process in which the court validates the will, appoints an executor, and distributes assets. This process can take time and can be expensive. Minimizing probate will require some planning, but being proactive now will make the process smoother for your heirs. The following are six ways to avoid probate court:

1. Create a Revocable Living Trust

If you want to avoid the probate process, putting your assets in a trust means they are not part of your estate. A trustee controls the distribution of assets and is obligated to make distributions under the terms of the trust agreement. You specify how you want your trust assets distributed similarly to a will. These assets will be transferred at the time of your death. In addition, the process is private rather than public, unlike the probate process.

2. Name Beneficiaries for Accounts

Some accounts aren't required to go through the probate process and will pass directly to beneficiaries. You can list beneficiaries for pension plans, life insurance policies, 401(k) plans 403(b) plans, accounts at a bank and through a securities brokerage, IRA accounts, and other investments. Check with a CPA or financial planner for potential tax consequences for heirs.

3. Own Property Jointly

Making your spouse or another individual a joint owner of the real property allows the asset to transfer without needing the probate process. There are several ways to set this up, including joint tenancy with the right of survivorship, tenancy by the entirety, and community property with the right of survivorship. An estate planning attorney or financial planner can assist with the process.

4. Make Accounts Payable on Death

You can designate your bank account as payable on death. These accounts will pass to your beneficiaries without the probate process. You can arrange this through your financial institution, and the account assets will go directly to your beneficiary.

5. Give Away Property While You're Alive

If you own property and want to minimize probate, consider giving away property to your loved ones while alive. You can also give away cash gifts but before doing so, consult your CPA.

6. Transfer on Death Provision for Securities and Vehicles

For securities accounts, you can sign a form indicating that the transfer should be made to your beneficiary upon death. The beneficiary can take possession of the asset only upon your death. There is no requirement for probate. The same rule applies to vehicles if the beneficiary presents identification and a death certificate.
